ID Number. A ten-character code assigned by ACE to identify each NEC exhibit.

CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTIONAL STANDARDS SPECIALIST

Title. The official Navy title of the NEC during the period of the exhibit dates.

Exhibit Dates. Start and end dates by month and year. An end date of "Present" indicates that the exhibit is current. "Pending Evaluation" means that an evaluation is scheduled.

Exhibit Dates: 1/90–2/05.

Career Pattern

Individuals holding NEC 9506 are in paygrades E-5 to E-9 and may hold any rating. The NEC may be awarded either by formal training or on-the-job training. Six months are usually required to attain a wide range of competency in all areas of the NEC. May have taken the Training Materials Development System (TMDS) Curriculum Developer course (A-012-0015).

Career Pattern. Shows prerequisite skills and training necessary for the award of the NEC and advancement in it.

Description. The skills, competencies, and knowledge required for proficiency in the NEC.

Description

Develops group-paced instructional materials in accordance with Navy curriculum development standards and guidelines; advises subject-matter experts on development procedures and formatting; evaluates curriculum documents and instructional delivery procedures; performs instructional assessment, test construction, review and validation of course competencies, and consistency of format for review of existing courses or the design of new courses.

Team Review Date. Date when the classification was last evaluated by a team of faculty members drawn from academia. This information is particularly useful in subject areas where state-of-the-art is important in determining the applicability of credit. ACE's policy is that Team Reviews must occur at least every ten years.

Recommendation. Educational credit is expressed in semester hours and recommended in four categories: vocational certificate, lower-division baccalaureate/associate degree, upper-division baccalaureate, and graduate degree.

Recommendation

In the upper-division baccalaureate category, 2 semester hours for a practicum/field experience in curriculum design or development (3/92)(3/92).

Review Date. Most recent date the classification was reviewed, either by an academic team or in-house by ACE (in-house reviews are conducted when changes to classification content are minor).
